New Local Law

Regulating Solid Waste Management and Recycling in the Village of Ellicottville.

January 21, 2021

Residents and landowners, please note there are new regulations pertaining to the storage, collection, and handling of solid waste (garbage) in the Village. Some key points are summarized below:

MONDAY TRASH PICK-UP INSTRUCTIONS

- Must have a "Suitable Receptacle"- a rodent proof rigid plastic, or metal container with lid sealed sufficiently to prevent vapor emissions and tight enough to prevent rodent intrusion, and no more than 40 gallons. The 40-gallon limit might be extended to 64 gallons provided it is in a tote with a metal lift bar determined by the Village to be compatible with the Village's refuse services collection truck.
- No Trash may be placed at the curb more than 24 hours before trash pickup. Pick-up starts at 6:00am Monday mornings.
- Trash receptacles must be removed from the curb no later than 24 hours after the trash has been picked up and placed at the rear of the building.
- It shall be a violation for any resident of the Village, landowner, lessee, or person in control of real property within the Village to permit any person to bring in, place or deposit any refuse or recyclables originating from outside the Village on any real property owned or leased by him or her or under his or her control for the purpose of disposal under the Village-operated waste disposal and recycling program.
- Violations of the new refuse law may incur penalties as follows:
 - For the first conviction, by a fine of \$200
 - For second conviction, within one year, by a fine of \$400
 - For the third conviction within one year, by a fine of \$600

Starting in February, the Village Department of Public Works (DPW) will issue a warning for the first offence and place trash receptacles at the house. They will only be issuing warnings through March 15, 2021.
